



Filming and sending your video files for GWD 2019

About your Videos

Please send us the best shots of your Ritual and/or Local dance: up to 3 minutes of footage, and the entirety of the Global Dance.

This year we are focusing on your **Local Water Issue** or **Environmental Action** so it would be great if you or your videographer would also send us some short interviews or testimonials from speakers, dancers, or audience members about your cause.

As we compile the footage for our Site Highlights (3minutes each), Impact Video, and Site Compilation (of all 170+ sites) we would like to add some shots of our audiences, so please include exciting footage of your audience members that you may have!

Specifications:

If possible, use:

- 16:9 Widescreen Aspect Ratio
- Preferably High Definition (minimum 1280 x 720, optimal 1920 x 1080)
- 29.97 FPS (Frames Per Second)

Footage:

- We will be respectful of your footage. Please understand that we cannot use everything that is sent to us.
- Send your footage either as a QuickTime (.MOV) or an .MP4 file with H.264 codec. However, we will be able to download other type of files.


Instructions for uploading your video and photo files

To send us your video and photos, you can use a secure website called WeTransfer using the instructions outlined below. This is free for you to use and enables large video files to be transferred securely over the Internet.


1. Go to <https://gwdances.wetransfer.com/>



2. Click the gray circle with "..." button at the bottom, left side



3. On the next screen, select "Send as Email" option.



4. If not already there, add the email address

GWD2019@globalwaterdances.org in "Email to:"

5. Add your email address in "Your email"


6. Add the location of your performance (city, country) and

Site Leader/Choreographer/Videographer names in "Message"

7. Add your video/photo files by clicking the (+) blue button (up to 20 GB when



selecting "Send as email" option!)



8. Click the "Transfer" button

9. The file will begin "Transferring" and will say, "Transfer complete" when this has been done. You will receive a confirmation email saying that your video has been sent to Global Water Dances

***Please be sure to send your videos **before July 25th, 2019**, to ensure the appearance of your site in our special video editions.

Notes:

Due to their large file size, video files can take a long time to upload and send over the Internet.

The time it takes will depend on your connection and broadband, 3G, 4G or WiFi speed.

We recommend that you do this during a quiet time of the day, perhaps when your Internet connection is not being shared with others, in order to complete this part of the process as quickly and easily as possible.
